
We have the latest technology for echocardiography – cardiac ultrasound including transesophageal echocardiography. Of course we have ECG and treadmill – ECG – testing and Holton – monit ing and Holter – moni-

toring. In addition we do ultrasound of carotid arteries and other arteries of the body. We are also prepared to do pacemaker follow-up and can rule out or confirm a heart attack with infarction immediately with the latest laboratory tests.

Who are the soldiers of Dubai's Centre?

The German Heart Centre is staffed with German cardiologists, all on senior consultant level, from our group in Bremen every day of the year. Currently four of our partners share the duty on rotation. These are myself, Dr. Helmut Lange, Boerner and Dr. Caspar Hachmoeller. We do rotation, because we want the patients in Dubai to profit from our continuous exposure to the very high caseload of 8000 interventional patients per year in our Bremen catheterization laboratories. In addition to these cases we see more than 25000 patients a year in our outpatient clinic. Thus, our Dubai clinic is active part of one of the busiest and most experienced programs in Germany and not a small stand-alone tacility. "We do not believe in visiting doctors. Heart patients need access to their cardiologists at any time. The Dubai centre can bring in seven senior consultant cardiologists depending on demand". To secure its excellent quality of services, the centre is also bringing
